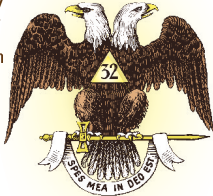

The make-up of the Library and Museum Board.

Currently, the L&M Board consists of seven active members. New members are elected by the remaining Board Members in the event of an opening (due to death or resignation).

The "Northeast Wisconsin" Library and Museum members are selected to represent NEW areas, such as; Sturgeon Bay, Menasha, Manawa, Marinette, Shawano, and Green Bay.

When new members are required, active Lodge members in the area affected are asked for recommendations, and the recommendations voted on by the current L&M board.

Since the L&M is a "Tax Exempt Private Operating Foundation," members are not considered from the current Building Board. This is intended to keep the L&M Foundation distinctly separate and "squeaky clean" and prevent any conflict of interest. The L&M is considered a renter, not an owner. The L&M meets the fifth Monday of the month and is open to guests. Please feel free to join us.
