

The Northeast Wisconsin Masonic Museum was closed from Mid-April until Mid-August due to repairs necessitated from water coming up through the cracks in the floor.

Luckily, no fixtures or artifacts were damaged, but the carpet needed replacing due to the staining and mold that had built up over the past few years from previous seepage of water.

The room was cleared, carpet removed, drain tile placed along the major cracks, other cracks sealed, and an additional sump pump installed.

New carpet squares were installed at a cost of about \$3,000.00 and the room assumed a whole new updated appearance. Please come down and visit the museum the next time you are in the building.
